Overview

The school began receiving the Sports Premium in September 2013. There is a basic grant to all schools and this is topped up by a per pupil element. The purpose of this funding is to support the provision of quality physical activities within the school. It can be used in many ways but the school is accountable to parents and governors for the way in which it is spent and we are required to publish this information on our website.

The purpose of this funding is to ensure improvement in the quality of sport and PE provision for all children. (Department for Education, March 2013).

We will ensure that sport and PE provision addresses the needs of all of pupils, including those who belong to disadvantaged, vulnerable and gifted groups

Objectives

- The Sports Premium will be used to provide additional opportunities in physical education. This may be on an individual, group, class or whole school level.
- Additional funding maybe used to address any underlying inequalities between children in the school, for example access to clubs, transport and equipment costs.
- We will ensure that the sports premium funding benefits all pupils
- To maintain and stimulate increased pupil interest in PE and to promote health and fitness for current and future lifestyles.
- To provide opportunities to allow pupils to broaden their PE experiences both during curriculum and extra curriculum time.
- To identify and develop those pupils who show specific aptitude for individual sports.
- The establishment of pupil self-esteem through the development of physical confidence.

Strategies

- The Sports Premium will be clearly identifiable within the budget
- The Headteacher, in consultation the Deputy Head and other staff, will decide how the Sports Premium is spent for the benefit of pupils.
- The school will assess what additional provision might be appropriate for individual pupils.
- The school will be accountable for how it has used the additional funding
- The Headteacher will report to the Governing Body on how effective the sports premium funding has been in achieving its aims.
