Linus Club

Dear Parents

Can you please read and take note of the information listed below.

- Places must be booked prior to the required session.
- A registration form with contact information must be completed on or before the first session.
 These can be collected from the school office or Linus Club.
- Children attending Linus Club **MUST** be escorted to and from the club by a responsible adult.
- Please inform Linus staff if someone other than yourself will be collecting your child. This
 ensures the safety of all children.
- Use of the school driveway is not allowed for safety reasons. It is used for deliveries throughout the day until 5 o'clock, and is a real danger to children if vehicles are reversing or turning.
- Parents must ensure that children are collected on time at the end of each session.
- All payments must be paid in full prior to attending Linus Club sessions.
- Any deficit payments may affect your child attending any future sessions.

Before and After School Club

- Linus club is available for children from Reception to Year 6
- Opening Times: morning session 7.45 9.00am & afternoon session 3.30 5.30pm
- Cereal, Toast and juice is provided in the morning session, between 7.45 and 8.30am
- Squash and biscuits are provided in the afternoon session
- Children must be booked in for each morning and afternoon session

If you wish to cancel a session which has been pre-booked, then Linus staff must be given 2 school days notice

If notice is not given, then the session fee will be charged for the place, whether the session is full or not

Children who are registered at Linus Club may also use the club following use of an after school activities club, such as sports practice or the art club. A fee of £3.00 would be payable.

General aims of Linus Club:

- To offer a warm, caring and safe environment for the children
- To provide an environment which encourages each child with the formation of their skills through activities and play
- To encourage each child to be confident and self-assured
- To enable each child to learn through first-hand experiences using a wide range of activities
- To encourage each child to develop their social skills with other children of varying ages
- To encourage all children using the club to be responsible and caring in their behaviour to other children

There are various activities and equipment, which are available for use by the children attending the club. For example, gaming consoles, computer equipment, art equipment etc. In addition, sporting equipment is also available for outdoor activities (weather permitting, in the afternoon sessions only).
