It's easy for children to fall out of their usual asthma care routine during the long summer break. For example, they may forget to take their preventer inhaler more often, which means their preventer medication hasn't had the time to build up and they are more sensitive to triggers when they go back to school.

Attendance

Please continue to make every effort to get your child/children in school everyday and on time. Be an Attendance Hero!!

Government legislation states that a child with an attendance of 90% and below is categorised as a "Persistent Absence". An attendance figure of 90% equates to missing half a day every week that means four weeks of missed school work across the whole year. Parents should also be aware that referrals to the school nurse will be considered for those children with an attendance rate of below 95% due to health related absences.

Attendance will be continued to be reviewed next academic year and families who are of concern will be contacted by either Mrs Taylor or Mrs Tibbott (our new attendance officer) and Mr Tomlin our LA attendance officer.
