Attentive and Discerning


Our topic focus:

Maths:

To:

- Take part in finger rhymes with numbers.
- Develop subitise up to 3 objects
- Show finger numbers to 5
- Identify and create patterns



During this half term we will be talking about God who cares for us.


Our other units later in the term will be Advent and Christmas.



Literacy:

To:

- Learn new vocabulary through stories
- Begin to form some letters in my name
- Make marks on paper
- Join in with songs and rhymes



UTW (Understanding the World):

- Show interest in different occupations
- Talk about what I see using new vocabulary.



EAD (Expressive Arts and Design):

Join different materials to create different textures.

CL (Communication and Language):

- Begin to understand why questions
- Sing a large variety of songs
- Use longer sentences of four to six words.



PSED (Personal, Social and Emotional development):

To:

- Follow rules and know why they're important
- Talk about my feelings and to begin to understand how others may be feeling
- Begin to play with others by extending play ideas

PD (Physical Development):

Indoors - Thursday (PE kits to be worn this day)

To:

- Explore different tools e.g. paint brushes, pencils, pens and scissors.
- Show a preference for a dominant hand
- Continue to develop movement and balancing skills
