
Our topic focus:

To:

- Count objects, actions and sounds
- Begin to explore and write numerals
- Explore 'more/less' to compare amounts



RE:

To:

PSED (Personal, Social and Emotional development):

To:

- Create friendships and play with other children
- Talk about my feelings with friends and familiar adults
- Become familiar and comfortable with my surroundings.

PD (Physical Development):
