

- To gather data and use it to answer a question
- To recognise that the strength of some materials can be changed
- To record data in a block graph
- To compare the suitability of materials for particular uses
- To recognise that some materials are harmful to the environment

Computing: Digital photography

We will be learning:



- To use a digital device to take a photograph
- To make choices when taking a photograph
- To describe what makes a good photograph
- To decide how photographs can be improved
- To know how to use tools to change an image
- To recognise that photos can be changed

Art: Painting and mixed media-Life in colour

We will be learning:

- To develop knowledge of colour mixing
- To learn how texture can be created with paint
- To use paint to explore texture and pattern
- To compose a collage, choosing and arranging materials for effect
- To evaluate and improve artwork
