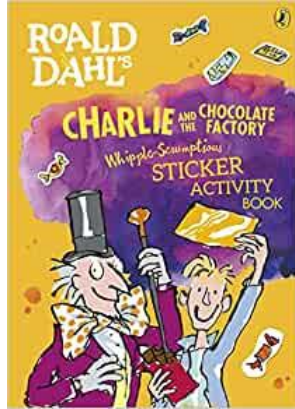

Intentional and Prophetic



English:

This term we will be exploring the text 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' by Roald Dahl. The children will be writing several pieces of work using descriptive language, similes and metaphors. The children will be continuing to develop their vocabulary and identify key features from the text over several guided reading lessons. During these lessons, the children will use their inference, retrieval, predicting and sequencing skills to answer a variety of questions about the text.



There will be more focus on presentation, handwriting and spellings. The children will continue to practice the 3/4 statutory word list. These spellings will be sent home weekly and need to be practiced.

RE:

Pentecost- In this unit children will learn about the story of Pentecost and recognise what the Holy Spirit brought to the lives of the Apostles. They will learn how the celebration of the Sacraments celebrates the presence of the Holy Spirit.



God's Word at Mass- the children will look at the order of mass and understand the meaning for each part.

RSE:

Throughout the term, we will be following the scheme 'Ten Ten'.

Community of Love- In this unit the children will be developing their understanding of the community aspect of the Holy Trinity and be encouraged to think about what the Holy Trinity means for them and their communities.

What is the Church?-In this session, children will learn about the wider Church and its mission to reflect the Holy Trinity through love for others.

Maths:

In maths the children will be learning more about time including; how to tell time and explore days, weeks and months.



Shape: the children will be learning about angles, turns, horizontal, vertical, parallel and perpendicular. They will also be learning about 2-D and 3-D shapes.

Topic:

Our creative curriculum topics for the summer term will be

Geography- land use. In this unit, the children will be learning about the different uses for land including, rural and urban. They will discuss, identify and present this through maps.

History-Royals in history.

In this unit, we will be looking at different monarchs in history and the lasting impact that they have had on our society.

Statistics: In this unit the children will learn about how data is presented and how they can present data through; pictograms, bar charts and tables.

D&T- Juggling.

In this unit, the children will investigate and analyse a range of existing products. They will evaluate their ideas and products against their own design criteria and consider the views of others to improve their work; generate, develop, model and communicate their ideas through discussion, annotated sketches, cross-sectional and exploded diagrams, prototypes, pattern pieces and computer-aided design; select from and use a wider range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks.

Music:

Throughout the term, we will be following the scheme 'Music Express'.

Human Body- in this unit the children will learn songs about the human body. They will use percussion instruments to improvise, create word rhythms and build a final skeleton dance.

Singing French- linking to the children's French lesson they will be learning how to enhance their understanding through songs.

Science:

Scientists and inventors. In this unit, the children will explore famous inventors and scientists from different periods/ they will explore what they have invented and how their inventions still influences our society today.

Computing:

Graphing-in this unit the children will be exploring how they can create different graphs. Children can input data that they have and gain experience in creating a graph to present this data.

Homework:

Timetable- the children need to be practicing their times table at home and they will be tested on them every week. The times tables to focus on include 2s, 5s, 10s, 3s, 4s and 8s.

Spellings- children will have spellings from the year 3 and 4 statutory spelling list which they need to practise and they will be tested every week on them.
