EAD (Expressive Arts and Design):

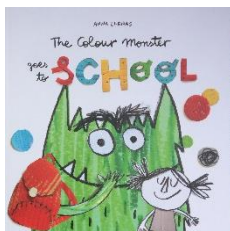
To:
