Nursery 30 Hour Child Care

Our aim is to be a provider for 30 hour childcare in Nursery. The aim is to have this set up in time for the start of the Summer Term (Monday 17th April). Some parents have been in contact to share that they are eligible—thank you. Please do let the office know if you are eligible as there are still places available presently.

I have been asked a few times what it means to be eligible. To check it is important to access the childcare website but please be informed of the following around eligibility:

You, and any partner, must each expect to earn (on average) at least £152 per week (equal to 16 hours at the National Minimum or Living Wage).

If you, or your partner, are on maternity, paternity or adoption leave, or you're unable to work because you are disabled or have caring responsibilities, you could still be eligible.

You **can't** get 30 hours free childcare if **either** you, or your partner, each **individually** expect to earn £100,000 or more.
