Maths:

Can I?

- Recognise odd and even numbers
- Identify double facts
- Share a number of objects equally
- Show number bonds to 5
- Show number bonds to 10
- Recognise 2D shapes
- Recognise 3D shapes

RE:

Easter

Children will learn about the story of Easter and the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead. They will be introduced to the "Alleluia" as a special Easter song and the symbol of the Easter candle.



Literacy:

Can I?

- Write simple sentences that can be read by others
- Spell words by identifying sounds in them and representing the sound with a letter or letters
- Read words by recognising sounds and blending to read the whole word
- Read simple sentences using my phonics skills

UTW (Understanding the World):

Can I?

- explore the natural world around me, making observations and drawing pictures of animals and plants
- describe my immediate environment
- understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around me

EAD (Expressive Arts and Design):

Can I?

- share my creations, explaining the process I have used
- sing a range of well-known nursery rhymes
- perform songs, rhymes, poems and stories with others and (when appropriate) try to move in time with music

CL (Communication and Language):

Can I?

- talk about what might happen in a story
- make comments about what I have heard and ask questions to clarify my understanding

PSED (Personal, Social and Emotional development):

Can I?

- show an understanding of my own feelings and those of others
- work and play cooperatively and take turns with others

PD (Physical Development):

Can I?

- use a range of small tools, including scissors, paintbrushes and cutlery
- begin to show accuracy and care when drawing
