Intentional and Prophetic

English:



This term we will be editing and improving some pieces of work that we have written earlier in the Year. We will also be writing about our visit to Alton Castle and creating an information leaflet about the venue and activities provided.

We will be continuing to practise our reading comprehension as well as writing our memories and speeches for our Leavers' Assembly.

RE: In RE will be learning about the liturgical year and why Pentecost is significant. We will also be finding out more about belonging to the Catholic Church. While learning about significant people, we will also be completing a project on our chosen Saint and why they are an inspiration to us. Children will also be meeting Bishop Stephen in readiness for their Confirmation.

RHE: Children will be learning about living in the wider world. Lessons include understanding the common good, the human person, social relationships and stewardship.

Maths:

In Maths we will be practising reading timetables, understanding money and how to be responsible for money as well as practising our arithmetic and reasoning skills.



We will also be completing some collaborative projects in class, in order to apply some of the skills we have already learned in Year 6.

Our project will focus on good team work as well as making good mathematical decisions for the better financial outcome of our project.

Topic:

Our creative curriculum topics for the spring term will be Global Food, The Seaside and Trade and Economics.



In Global Food we will find out more about where ingredients come from as well as learning about cuisine from around the world. In our Seaside topic we will be looking at shells and seaside scenes. In our topic of Trade and Economics, we will be learning about fair trade and who we trade with.

Music:

In music we will be completing the topic of Moving on. In this unit we will work together to create a performance. We will also learn about Class Awards where again collaboratively, children will work to write a rap and develop a performance of a song.



Science:

During our science lessons, children will be learning about light and electricity - gaining a better understanding of circuits. We will also find out about how sight works and what a light source is. Our other topic in science is animals including humans.



Computing:

Through our computing unit we will be learning about how to create a quiz as well as binary form and converting decimal to binary.

Homework in Year 6 will be to continue to practise skills on IXL, read daily and to practise spellings and timetables.
