



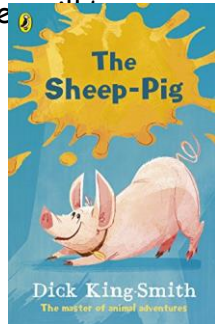
Year 3 Summer Term 1 2026

Learning together, Loving God, Becoming the best I can.



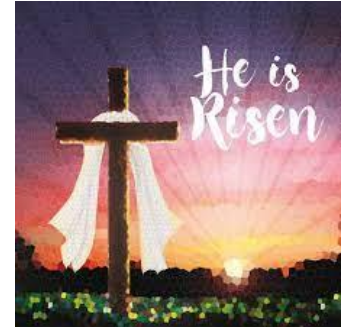
English:

This term we will be continuing to work on The Hodgeheg and also looking at the book 'Sheep pig' by Dick King-Smith. The children will be writing several pieces of work using descriptive language, similes and metaphors. The children will be continuing to develop their vocabulary and identify key features from the text over several reading lessons. During these lessons, the children will use their inference, retrieval, predicting and sequencing skills to answer a variety of questions about the text.



There will be a continued focus on presentation, handwriting and spellings.

RE: Easter- in this unit the children will learn about the Stories of the Road to Emmaus and Breakfast at the Shore. They will be focusing on how the Church celebrates Jesus through the Eucharist.



RSE: Throughout the term, we will be following the scheme 'Ten Ten'.

Community of Love- In this unit the children will be developing their understanding of the community aspect of the Holy Trinity and be encouraged to think about what the Holy Trinity means for them and their communities.

What is the Church?-In this session, children will learn about the wider Church and its mission to reflect the Holy Trinity through love for others.

Maths: Throughout the term, we will be following the 'White Rose' maths scheme.

Fractions- in this unit the children will be learning how to add and subtract fractions. They will learn how to partition a whole, use unit and non-unit fractions.

Money- in this unit the children will be learning about pounds and pence. They will also be learning about how to convert pounds and pence, add and subtract money and find change.



Geography:

Our creative curriculum topics for the summer term will be

Geography - Rio and South East Brazil. They will learn key facts about the South American country of Brazil and be able to locate it on a map.

ART- Drawing and Sketching.

In this unit children will learn:

- to create sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas
- to improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of

materials [for example, pencil, charcoal, paint, clay]

- to know about great artists, architects and designers in history

Music: The children will continue to have lessons with our music teacher Miss Scoines from Rockit music. They have been learning all about musical notation and using instrument such as drums and keyboards.



Science: Plants and growth.

In this unit the children will be learning about plants and growth. They will learning about what a plant needs to survive, different parts of plants, pollinations and how water is transported through plants.



Computing: Teach Computing.

Creating media - Desktop publishing

During this unit, learners will become familiar with the terms 'text' and 'images' and understand that they can be used to communicate messages. They will use desktop publishing software and consider careful choices of font size, colour and type to edit and improve premade documents. Learners will be introduced to the terms 'templates', 'orientation', and 'placeholders' and begin to understand how these can support them in making their own template for a magazine front cover. They will start to add text and images to create their own pieces of work using desktop publishing software.

Homework:

Timetable- the children need to be practicing their times table at home and they will be tested on them every week. The times tables to focus on include 2s, 5s, 10s, 3s, 4s, 6s and 8s.
