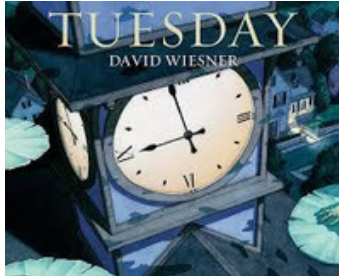
English:

This term we will be exploring the text 'Tuesday' The children will be writing several pieces of work using descriptive language, similes and metaphors.

RSE:

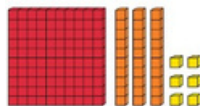
Throughout the term, we will be following the scheme 'Ten Ten'.

In maths the children will be learning more about place value as well as ordering and counting numbers up to 1000.



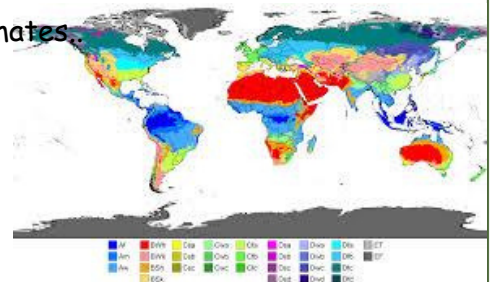
The children will be exploring different methods used to calculate using the four

Music: Keyboards with Rock it music.

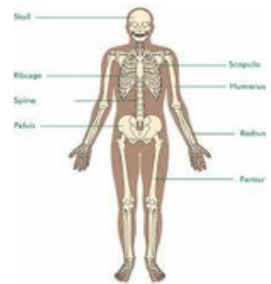
The children will be having music lessons every Monday with our new music teacher from Rock it music. The children will be learning how to play different songs on the keyboard.
