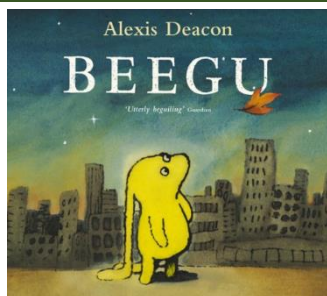

Our focus text this half term is Beegu. In our writing we will be exploring illustrations and using adjectives to describe a character, including their thoughts and feelings. We will also be continuing our focus on the importance of sentence structure including; capital letters, fingers spaces, full stops and using our conjunctions 'and' or 'but' within our sentences.

In our reading we will be developing our key skills when answering questions about our class text, as well as thinking of our own questions to ask, including taking on the role of a character!

We will have daily Phonics lessons revising and revisiting previously taught sounds each day to help develop our reading and writing skills.

RE:

Easter

We will be learning that Easter celebrates the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead and deepening our understanding of what the Resurrection of Jesus means and the impact it has on others. We will also know the story of the women finding the empty tomb and we will be exploring and explaining the significance and symbolism of the Easter candle.



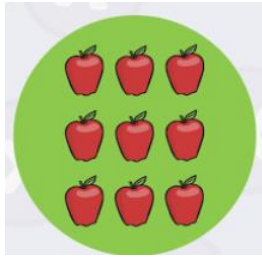
Maths: Multiplication and Division

During this half term, we will be looking at multiplication and division. This will include counting in 2's, 5's and 10's, recognising equal groups, making arrays, exploring doubles and also grouping amounts.

Geography: Local area

We will be:

- Spotting the differences between urban and rural areas.
- Exploring the features of our school grounds.
- Recording the features of our local area.
- Recognising symbols used on an ordnance survey map.
- Creating a map of our local area.





















Music: Rock It Music

We will be taking part in music lessons with our Music teacher. We will learn how to play musical instruments and understand how to read music and the different features of music.



Science: Animals

We will be discovering animal families and learning the differences between different animal groups such as; mammals, birds, amphibians, reptiles and fish. We will explore the types of foods they eat, the characteristics of an animal and also the differences between wild animals and pets.
