



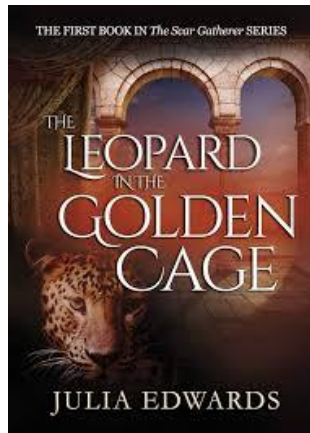
Year 4 Summer Term 1 2026

English:

Our focus text this half term is *The Leopard in the Golden Cage*. We will be writing a setting description.



Throughout our writing we will be using expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials, sentence openers and conjunctions.

During our comprehension lessons we will be using our inference, retrieval, predicting and sequencing skills to answer questions on a variety of texts. There will be a clear focus on handwriting and presentation and we will continue to develop our knowledge on spelling patterns from the statutory year 3/4 word list.

Easter

We will be introduced to accounts of the Resurrection appearance of Christ in the four Gospels. We will learn about the different reactions to the news that Christ was alive. We will study the story of the Ascension and the Christian belief in the presence of Christ in the world today,



Maths:

We will be learning:

- To make a whole with tenths and hundredths
- To partition, compare and order decimals
- To round to the nearest whole number
- To write money using decimals
- To convert between pounds and pence
- To compare amounts of money
- To estimate, calculate and solve problems with money

History

We will be learning:

- To describe the different groups that lived in the British Isles at the end of Roman rule in Britain
- To explain how the Angles, Saxons and Jutes came to Britain
- To describe how early Anglo-Saxon Britain was made up of different kingdoms
- To describe how Christianity returned to the British Isles





- To explain how archaeologists have used grave goods to make inferences about Anglo-Saxon Britain
- To understand some of the different roles women had in Anglo-Saxon society and how historians know about these

Music: Rock It Music

We will be taking part in music lessons with our Music teacher. We will learn how to play musical instruments and understand how to read music and the different features of music.



Science: Sound

We will be learning:

- To identify how sounds are made
- To explore how vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear
- To explore sound insulation
- To explore volume
- To explore pitch
- To explore sounds from near and from far



Computing: Creating media-Photo editing

We will be learning:

- To explain that the composition of digital images can be changed
- To explain that colours can be changed in digital images
- To explain how cloning can be used in photo editing
- To explain that images can be combined
- To combine images for a purpose
- To evaluate how changes can improve an image
