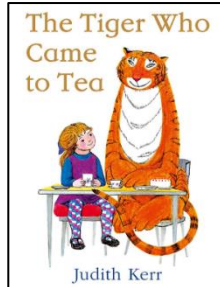

Curious and Active

English:

The Tiger who came to Tea.

Our focus text this half term is The Tiger who came to Tea. In our writing we will be generating adjectives to describe the character of the tiger, as well as creating invitations to invite the tiger for a tea party. We will be focusing on the importance of sentence structure including; capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and exploring the conjunction 'and'.



In our reading we will be developing our key skills when answering questions about our class text, as well as thinking of our own questions to ask.

We will have daily Read Write Inc lessons learning new sounds each day to help develop our reading and writing skills.

RE:

Christmas

We will be exploring the annunciation, the journey of Mary and Joseph, including Joseph's dream and the birth of Jesus.



Jesus Teacher and Healer

We will be learning about the life of Jesus and how he taught people about God. We will also be learning about how Jesus helped others to live their lives by telling parables. We explore the Good Samaritan and talk about what we believe Jesus wants us to know from this story.

Maths: Addition/subtraction and shape.

During this half term, we will be looking at place value within 20, as well as addition and subtraction within 20. We will be reading stem sentences and using different resources to help us work out our answers such as; number lines, cubes, counters/10 frames, rekenreks and our fingers.



Geography: United Kingdom

We will be:

- Locating the 4 countries within the U.K.
- Recognising the 4 capital cities and surrounding seas.
- Explain the difference between human and physical features
- Describe the human/physical features of the 4 capital cities
- To share our understanding of the 4 countries



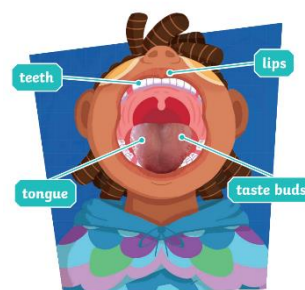
Music

We will be taking part in music lessons with our Music teacher. We will learn how to play musical instruments and understand how to read music and the different features of music.



Science: All about me! Humans.

We will be looking and labelling our basic body parts, exploring our eyes and sight, our ears and hearing, our tongue and how we taste things, our sense of touch and finally nose and smell.
