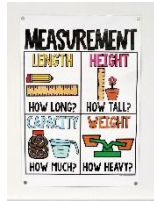
Our topic focus:

All about me- lifecycles and ourselves / Spring

Maths: Number 6, height and length, mass and capacity

This half term in Nursery we will be:

- making comparisons between objects relating to size, length, weight, and capacity.
- To find the longer or shorter, heavier or lighter and full of two items.
- To be able to count 6 items.



RE:

During this half term we will be looking at Lent with a focus on the relationship between Jesus and His Father. We need to say sorry when we fail to show love and care.



Literacy:

To:

- Repeat words and phrases from familiar stories.
- Engage in conversations about stories and to learn new vocabulary.
- Recognise our names and write some/all letters in our name.
- Join in with songs and rhymes.



UTW (Understanding the World):

To:

- Understand the key features of the life cycle of a plant and animal.
- Begin to understand need to respect and care for all living things.
- This will be done by observing and caring for chick eggs and learn about how we grow.

EAD (Expressive Arts and Design):

To:

- Begin to develop complex stories in roleplay and negotiate roles in play and create roles for each other in the home corner.
- Show different emotions in their drawings.

CL (Communication and Language):

To:

- To discuss how I am feeling.
- Listen to simple stories and discuss what is happening.
- Answer questions about what they have listened to/learnt.
- Use talk to organise themselves and their play: "You be the mum and I'll be the baby" etc

PSED (Personal, Social and Emotional development):

To:

- Express preferences and choices in the nursery environment.
- To communicate with others and understand how they and others feel.
- Extend and elaborate play ideas with other children in the classroom.

PD (Physical Development):

To:

Indoors – Thursday (PE kits to be worn this day)

- Explore different materials e.g. paint, tissue paper, brushes, pens
- Organise and match items, images and colours. Work with a partner to listen and share ideas and questions.
- Send and receive variety of objects with different body parts.
