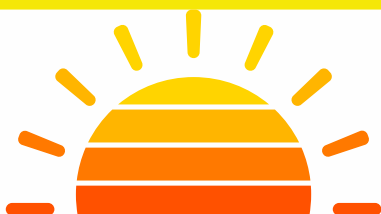
Miss Betts will be getting married during the Summer Break, so will be known from September as Mrs Martin. We wish the happy couple many congratulations and a wonderful life together.
