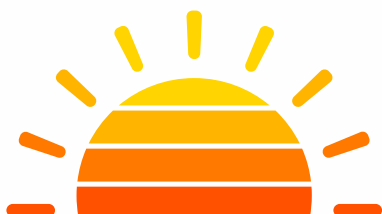
Thank you for your continued support throughout the year. On behalf of all the staff and governors, I wish you and your families a restful and enjoyable summer break.
